

REGULAR MEETING

Tuesday, May 4, 1954

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, met in the Council Chamber in the City Hall on Tuesday, May 4, 1954, at the hour of seven-thirty o'clock p.m. (7:30 p.m.) in regular session with Mayor Kelly presiding.

Members Present: Carpenter, Donham, Griffith, McDaniel, Miller, Porter, and Ramsey

Members Absent: None

The minutes of the last meeting were approved on motion of Councilman Ramsey, seconded by Councilman Porter.

The report of Horace Robertson, Chief of the Fire Department, for the month of April, 1954, was approved on motion of Councilman Miller, seconded by Councilman McDaniel.


The report of L. M. Rogers, Superintendent of the Sanitation Department for the month of April, 1954, was accepted on motion of Councilman Donham, seconded by Councilman Porter.

The report of J. N. Gilmore, Street Commissioner, for the month of April, 1954, was approved on motion of Councilman McDaniel, seconded by Councilman Donham.

Councilman Griffith reported for the Committee on Rules, Ordinances, and Printing in connection with the proposed Ordinance establishing rules to govern the proceedings of the Common Council and explained the amendments to the Ordinance recommended by the Committee. Councilman Griffith moved the adoption of the amendments to the Ordinance. Councilman Miller seconded motion; motion carried.

Councilman Griffith asked the Council if the title only might be read for the second reading of the Ordinance and received consent. The Clerk-Treasurer presented the seconded reading of the Rules Ordinance. On motion of Councilman Griffith, seconded by Councilman Miller, to adopt the Ordinance on a rollcall vote, the response was as follows: Ayes: Carpenter, Donham, Griffith, McDaniel, Miller and Porter; Nos: Ramsey. Whereupon Ordinance No. 7, 1954, titled "An Ordinance establishing Rules to govern the Proceedings of the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana: and repealing any Ordinance or rules heretofore adopted which may be in conflict therewith" was declared duly passed and adopted.

The meeting adjourned on motion of Councilman Carpenter, seconded by Councilman Porter.
