

STATUTORY MEETING

Monday, August 31, 1953


THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, met in a special statutory session in the City Hall, Bloomington, Indiana, August 31, 1953, at the hour of seven-thirty o'clock P.M. with Mayor Kelly presiding.

Members Present: Griffith, Miller, and Porter

Members Absent: Carpenter, Fowler, McDaniel, and Ramsey

Mayor Kelly stated that this statutory meeting was for the purpose of acting on the appropriations for the budget for 1954 and the amount of appropriation for each department was read to the Council. Mayor Kelly inquired if anyone present had any objections or questions concerning the proposed budget for 1954. There were no objections or questions. Councilman Miller moved the adoption of the budget, as read; seconded by Councilman Porter; motion carried, and Appropriation Ordinance No. 2, 1953, being the budget for the City of Bloomington for the year 1954, was declared duly adopted.

Councilman Griffith moved the meeting recess subject to recall by Mayor Kelly at a time when sufficient members of the Council can be present to form a quorum, for the purpose of confirming the action of the members of the Council present at this meeting; and to consider any other matters that require attention at that time. Councilman Porter seconded the motion; motion carried.
