

SPECIAL MEETING

July 22, 1952

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, met in a special called session in the Council Chamber at the City Hall, Bloomington, Indiana July 22, 1952 at the hour of 6:30 P.M., with Mayor Kelly presiding.

Members present: Carpenter, Fowler, Griffith, McDaniel, Miller, Porter, and Ramsey

Members absent: none

Mr. Fowler moved that the reading of the minutes of the last regular meeting be dispensed with at this meeting with the understanding that they will be read at the next regular meeting. Councilman Porter seconded the motion; motion carried.

Councilman Ramsey reported for the committee on Recreation, Education and Public Health that the committee had reviewed selection of persons to serve on the City School Board to replace the members whose terms are expiring August 1, 1952. Councilman Miller moved that the two members whose terms are expiring August 1, 1952, be reappointed to the Board of School Trustees. Councilman Porter seconded the motion; on a roll call vote, the response was as follows: Carpenter, abstained; ayes: Fowler, McDaniel, Miller, Porter and Ramsey; Nays: Griffith; motion carried.

Councilman Fowler moved that a letter be sent to Mr. Wylie and Mr. Graves informing them of their reappointment to the School Board. Mr. Miller seconded the motion; motion carried.

City Attorney McGrea presented to the Board proposal to purchase from the School Trustees the land area of the Central School for purposes of off-street parking. After discussion, Councilman Carpenter moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

RESOLUTION NO. 6, 1952

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, that the Common Council approve of the proposal to acquire the Central School land area at a cost of \$50,000 to be paid from parking meter funds now accumulated, to be appropriated from general funds by the Common Council for this purpose.

Councilman Griffith seconded the motion; motion carried.

Councilman Carpenter moved that the special session of the Council adjourn and go immediately into Committee session to discuss budget estimates. Councilman Porter seconded the motion; motion carried.
