THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, met in regular session in the Council Chamber at the City Hall, Bloomington, Indiana, August 5, 1952, at the hour of six-thirty o'clock P.M. (6:30 P.M.), with Mayor Kelly presiding.

Members present: Carpenter, Fowler, Miller, Porter, and Ramsey

Members absent: Griffith, and McDaniel

The minutes of the regular meeting July 15, 1952, were approved on motion of Councilman Carpenter, seconded by Councilman Porter.

The minutes of the special meeting July 22, 1952, were approved on motion of Councilman Fowler, seconded by Councilman Porter.

A petition was received from Gale Baugh for permission to move a building from 111 South Jordan Street to a location one-half block/of Seventh Street on Jefferson Street. Councilman Carpenter moved permission be granted, providing that Mr. Baugh meet the requirements of the City Engineer and the City Attorney; Councilman Fowler seconded the motion; motion carried.

The report of Morace Robertson, Chief of the Fire Department, for the month of July 1952, was presented to the Council, and accepted on motion of Councilman Fowler, seconded by Councilman Carpenter.

The report of J. N. Gilmore, StreetCommissioner, for the month of July 1952, was presented to the Council, and accepted on motion of Councilman Miller, seconded by Councilman Carpenter.

The report of L. M. Rogers, Superintendent of the Sanitation Department, was presented to the Council, and accepted on motion of Councilman Porter, seconded by Councilman Carpenter.

City Engineer Cason reported that he had investigated the surface water drainage situation presented by George T. Burch, 510 West Dodds Street. He recommended that Mr. Burch cut the sidewalk and curb to provide drainage. Councilman Ramsey moved that Mr. Burch's request be approved, providing the drain goes under the sidewalk to the street, and that the work be done under the supervision of the City Engineer. Councilman Fowler seconded the motion; motion carried.

Councilman Miller reported for the Committee and Sidewalk and Street Lighting, advising that the committee recommended that a street light be approved for Hillside Drive between Grant Street and Henderson Street. Councilman Miller moved that this street light be approved by the Council, and the Public Service Company instructed to install the light. Councilman Porter seconded the motion; motion carried.

On motion of Councilman Carpenter, seconded by Councilman Miller, the meeting adjourned.
