

REGULAR MEETING

Tuesday, September 16, 1952

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, met in regular session in the Council Chamber at the City Hall, Bloomington, Indiana, September 16, 1952, at the hour of six-thirty (6:30) P.M.

Members present: Carpenter, Fowler, Griffith, McDaniel, Miller, Porter and Ramsey

Members absent: none

The minutes of the regular meeting September 2, 1952, were approved by the Council upon motion of Councilman Griffith, seconded by Councilman Carpenter.

In the absence of Mayor Kelly, Presiding Officer, the Council unanimously elected Councilman Fowler to preside over this meeting.

A letter was received from J. R. Smallwood, 412 North Morton Street, Bloomington, Indiana, requesting permission to cut curb at 309 North Walnut Street for parking lot commencing just south of water meter. Councilman Miller moved that the request be referred to the Committee on Streets, Alleys and Bridges; Councilman McDaniel seconded the motion; motion carried.

A request was received from Mrs. Bertha M. Peregrine, 330 S. Maple Street, Bloomington, Indiana, for permission to put a driveway across the sidewalk on part of Seminary lot No. 49 for purpose of having coal unloaded into the basement. The said lot being owned and occupied by Bertha M. Peregrine. Councilman McDaniel moved the petition be referred to the Committee on Streets, Alleys and Bridges; Councilman Miller seconded the motion; motion carried.

An application for a license to operate a Taxi Cab business in the City of Bloomington, Indiana, was received from Jack Dorsey, 1017 S. Walnut Street. Councilman Miller moved that the matter be referred to the Committee on Finance, Claims, and Franchises for investigation and reported on at a future meeting; Councilman McDaniel seconded the motion; motion carried.

The report of Leonard M. Rogers, Sanitation Superintendent, was presented to the Council for the month of August, 1952, and accepted on motion of Councilman McDaniel; seconded by Councilman Miller; motion carried.

J. Newton Gilmore, Street Commissioner, presented his report for the month of August, 1952. Councilman McDaniel moved the report be accepted as read; Councilman Porter seconded the motion; motion carried.

Councilman Miller reported for the Committee on Sidewalks and Street Lighting that street lights have been installed on Hillside and Dunn Street.

When the question of the re-zoning Ordinance was brought up, Councilman Miller moved that the Council post-pone action on this Ordinance until the next regular meeting; Councilman McDaniel seconded the motion; motion carried.

The meeting adjourned on motion of Councilman Miller, seconded by Councilman McDaniel.
