

REGULAR MEETING

THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, met in Regular Session in the Council Chambers at 7:30 o'clock P. M., on Tuesday, January 2, 1951, with Mayor Lemon presiding.

ROLL CALL:

The minutes of the last special meeting were read by the Clerk-Treasurer and approved as read upon motion by Councilman Dunn, seconded by Councilman Chitwood. Motion carried.

An application for Taxi License was presented to the Council for consideration from H. Cecil McNeely of Yellow Cab Company.

Councilman Dunn moved this application be refused on the basis that the policy does not meet the requirements to the public. The policy should have a Fleet Coverage, not a detail coverage, and the petition should be signed by petitioner. Seconded by Councilman Chitwood, motion carried.

FIRE REPORT

Fire Chief Glover gave the fire report for the year 1950. Councilman Parks moved this report be accepted and placed on file in the Clerk-Treasurer's office. Seconded by Councilman Chitwood, motion carried.

Councilman Sikes moved the Mayor appoint a committee to promote the naming of the park in the Southeast part of the City, and the park on West Second Street. The findings are to be submitted to the Council for approval. Seconded by Councilman Chitwood, motion carried.

Claims Nos. 1 to 71, inclusive, were approved and warrants ordered issued in the amount of \$37,683.31 upon motion by Councilwoman Woolery, seconded by Councilman Parks, and carried.

Upon motion by Councilwoman Woolery, seconded by Councilman Chitwood, the meeting adjourned.
