## REGULAR MEETING

TUESDAY, Feb. 6, 1951.

THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, met in Regular Session in the Council Chamber at 7:30 o'clock P. M. on Tuesday, February 6, 1951, with Mayor Lemon presiding.

ROLL CALL:

The minutes of the last regular meeting were read and approved as read upon motion by Councilman Chitwood, seconded by Councilman Dunn and carried.

## PETITIONS:

A Petition from Richard E. McGuire at 1008 E. Seventeenth Street was read, requesting a street light at the intersection of 17th Street and Walnut Grove.

Councilman Chitwood moved the above petition be referred to the Light Committee and they are to report back at next Council meeting. Seconded by Councilman Sikes, motion carried.

The Clerk-Treasurer presented an application for Taxi License from Wm. Wayne and Alice Wampler, d/b/a I. U. Cab Company, for the Council's consideration.

Councilman Dunn moved this application be granted after the insurance is corrected to correspond with said application. Seconded by Councilman Chitwood, motion carried.

Councilman Sikes moved the City Attorney be instructed to draw up an Ordinance amending Taxie Cab License Ordinance to cover the City of Bloomington in all respects with a Fleet coverage, with a hearing to be held on a later date. Seconded by Councilman Chitwood, motion carried.

The Clerk-Treasurer presented to the Council for approval the Financial Report for the City for 1950. Councilman Shank moved the report be accepted and placed on file in the Clerk-Treasurer's office. Seconded by Councilman Chitwood, motion carried.

## MONTHLY REPORTS:

Street Commissioner Marlin presented the Street Report for the month of January, 1951. Upon motion by Councilman Shank, seconded by Councilman Sikes and carried, the report was approved and ordered placed on file in the Clerk-Treasurer's office.

Fire Chief Glover presented the Fire Report for the month of January, 1951. The report was approved and ordered placed on file in the Clerk-Treasurer's office upon motion by Councilwoman Woolery, seconded by Councilman Shank and carried.

J. T. Femal presented the Recreation report to the Council for the year 1950.

Councilman Sikes moved the Recreation Department be commended for excellent report and ordered it to be placed on file in the Olerk-Treasurer's office. Seconded by Councilwoman Woolery, motion carried.

Judge Donald A. Rogers presented to the Council and application from Dr. Floyd and Ruth Rogers to have the west boundary of the sidewalk on Inlot No. 25 vacated. Councilman Chitwood the City Attorney not oppose the suit of Floyd & Ruth Rogers vs the City of Bloomington. Seconded by Councilwoman Woolery, motion carried.

Upon motion by Councilwoman Woolery, seconded by Douncilman Dunn, Claims Nos. 219 to 398, inclusive, in the total amount of \$44,347.51 were approved and warrants ordered issued. Motion carried.
