REGULAR MEETING

TUESDAY, MARCH 20, 1951.

THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, met in Regular Session in the Council Chamber at 7:30 o'clock P. M. on Tuesday, March 20, 1951.

Clerk-Treasurer Carl O. Stewart moved Councilwoman Woolery act as Mayor protempore in the absence of Mayor Lemon; seconded by Councilman Sikes. Upon a roll call vote, the vote was unamimous.

ROLL C ALL:

Present: Chitwood, Dunn, Parks, Shank, Sikes, Woolery. Absent: Black.

The minutes of the last regular meeting were read and approved as read upon motion by Councilman Chitwood, seconded by Councilman Dunn and carried.

The Clerk-Treasurer read a letter from Dr. William Lowe Bryan expressing his appreciation to the Council and the Park-Naming Contest Committee for naming the new City Park the "William Lowe Bryan Park".

A letter was also read from Dr. Herman B Wells thanking the Council and the Committee for choosing the name given to the new City Park.

Councilman Shank moved that Chauncey Wooden permitted to cut curb for a distance of 12 feet at 604 S. Washington Street, as per his petition presented at the last Council meeting. Motion seconded by Councilman Parks and carried.

Attorney Regester presented proofs of publications from two newspapers of general circulation on Feb. 23, 1951 and March 2, 1951, that on this date, March 20, 1951, the Council would consider Special Appropriation Ordinance #1, 1951.

Councilman Chitwood moved Special Appropriation Ordinance #1, 1951 be adopted, seconded by Councilman Dunn. Upon a roll call vote, the vote was unanimous in favor of adoption. Special Appropriation Ordinance #1, 1951 is now duly adopted.

Councilman Sikes introduced Ordinance #2, 1951 for its second reading.

Upon motion by Councilman Chitwood, seconded by Councilman Shank, Claims Nos. 654 to 806, inclusive, were approved, and Warrants ordered issued in the total amount of \$32,025.02. Motion carried.

Agnes Woolery, Mayor Protempore, declared the meeting adjourned as there was no further business.
