

REGULAR MEETING

TUESDAY, MAY 15, 1951.

THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, met in regular session in the Council Chamber at 6:30 P. M., CST., with Mayor Lemon presiding.

ROLL CALL: Present - Chitwood, Dunn,^P Shank, Sikes, Woolery
Absent - Black, Parks.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved as read upon motion by Councilman Dunn, seconded by Councilwoman Woolery. Motion carried.

PETITIONS

A petition from Russell W. Abram of 1106 E. Cottage Grove asking permission to move a five room house from 1514 E. 10th St. to 312 Arbutus Ave., the mover to be John Gray.

Councilman Shank moved the above petition be allowed when Mr. Abram has complied with the rules of City Engineer and has a surety bond and insurance filed in the Clerk-Treasurer's office. Seconded by Councilman Chitwood, motion carried.

A petition was received from Jack W. Walker of 609 S. Grant St. asking permission to cut curb and sidewalk for a distance of 12 feet for entrance to garage.

Councilman Shank moved Mr. Walker's petition be granted provided work is done under the supervision of City Engineer. Seconded by Councilman Chitwood, motion carried.

A petition was received from Roger Curry to move a frame house from 422 S. Camel St. to Lots #25 & 26, Block "T", Highland Homes Addition, the mover to be John Gray.

Councilman Chitwood moved the above petition be granted and turned over to the house moving committee with the power to act, and that Roger Curry comply with specifications of City Engineer's office and also place required insurance on file in the Clerk-Treasurer's office. Seconded by Councilwoman Woolery, motion carried.

STREET LIGHT

A petition from 19 property owners requesting the installation of a street light at the intersection of Grant and Davis Streets was received.

Councilman Chitwood moved this petition be referred to the Light Committee for study and report at the next Council meeting; seconded by Councilwoman Woolery, motion carried.

A ten minute recess was called by Mayor Lemon.

After the meeting was resumed, a discussion of the Boundary Line between Cascade Park and the Bloomington Crushed Stone Company was held. The City Park Board had requested a legal survey of said boundary line by the Board of Works.


Ralph Rogers, owner of the Bloomington Crushed Stone Company explained that to construct a desirable new road, it will be necessary for him to eliminate part or all of the boundary line road now existing to an extent of possibly 15 feet beyond the present road.

Councilman Chitwood moved the Council give permission to Mr. Rogers to proceed as per oral contract in completing the job he has started, and the oral contract be reduced to writing under supervision of City Attorney, City Engineer and City Park Board, and this written contract be a record in the Council minutes. Seconded by Councilwoman Woolery, motion carried.
