#### TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 18, 1951

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The COMMON COUNCIL of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, met in regular session in the Council Chamber on Tuesday, September 18, 1951 at 7:30 o'clock, P. M., with Mayor Lemon presiding.

Upon roll call, the following members werefound to be present: Black, Chitwood, Dunn, Parks, Shank, Sikes and Woolery; absent: None.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved as read upon motion by Councilwoman Woolery, seconded by Councilman Dunn and carried.

## Petition to Cut Curb:

Lerey Baker and Viva O. Baker, owners of the premises at 502 S. Jordan Ave. presented a petition requesting permission to cut the curb and sidewalk at the above premises for a distance of 12 feet in order to secure better entrance. Motion was made by Councilman Shank, seconded by Councilman Parks and carried that the Council approve the petition subject to the work being done by a bonded contractor and under the supervision of the City Engineer.

## Petition for Street Light:

Several residents of the area surrounding the junction of 7th St. and N. Clark St. presented a petition requesting the City to install a street light at the above named corner. Motion was made by Councilman Chitwood, seconded by Councilman Shank and carried, that this petition be referred to the light Committee for report at the next Council meeting.

#### Monthly Report:

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Glenn Marlin, Street Commissioner, presented his report for the month of August, 1951. Councilman Parks moved this report be approved and ordered placed on file in the Clerk-Treasurer's office; motion seconded by Councilman Sikes and carried.

### Request of Board of Aviation Commissioners:

Mr. John Stempel, representing that Board of Aviation Commissioners, requested the Council to authorize a petition to the State Tax Board requesting that Board to restore to the Aviation Department part of the cuts that were taken from their 1952 budget. Motion was made by Councilman Dunn that the Council not authorize a petition to the State Tax Board for reinstatement of funds to Aviation Board budget; motion seconded by Councilman Sikes and upon roll call vote, the vote was as follows: Black, aye; Dunn, aye; Chitwood, aye; Parks, aye; Shank, naye; Sikes, aye; Woolery, aye. Motion carried.

# Report from Street Light Committee:

Councilman Chitwood moved that a Street Light be installed at the corner of 13th St. and Faculty Ave. Motion seconded by Councilman Black and carried.

#### Claims:

Motion was made by Councilman Black, seconded by Councilwoman Woolery and carried that Claims Nos. 2499 to 2621, inclusive, be approved and warrants ordered issued in the total amount of \$31,924.42.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
