

REGULAR MEETING

TUESDAY, OCTOBER 3, 1950.

THE COMMON COUNCIL met in regular session in the Council Chamber on Tuesday, October 3, 1950, at 7:30 o'clock, P. M., with Mayor Lemon presiding.

Roll Call:

Present: Black, Chitwood, Dunn, Parks, Shank, Sikes, Woolery.

Absent: None

The minutes of the last regular meeting were read and approved as read upon motion of Councilwoman Woolery, seconded by Councilman Black and carried.

PETITIONS:

A petition from Mrs. Milton Richey of 617 N. Washington Street was presented to the Council, asking permission to cut curb and sidewalk as matter of necessity to the entrance of her garage. Councilman Shank moved this petition be referred to the Street Committee and that they be given the power to act. This work is to be done under the supervision of the City Engineer. Seconded by Councilman Chitwood, motion carried.

Mr. Ben L. Wallace, 714 S. Park, and Mr. & Mrs. Grover Willoughby, 422 E. 16th St., submitted a petition asking the Council for permission to move a house from present location, 231 Sunrise Drive, a four room house now owned by Indiana University.

Councilwoman Woolery moved the above petition be granted with the stipulation that whoever does the moving meets bond and insurance requirements to protect against street damage and personal injury or other property damage that might be caused by the moving. Seconded by Councilman Black, motion carried.

Councilman Black moved the Street Committee approve said route the house is to be taken over. Seconded by Councilwoman Woolery, motion carried.


FIRE REPORT:

Chief Glover submitted the fire report for the month of September. Councilman Dunn moved this report be accepted and placed on file in the Clerk-Treasurer's office. Seconded by Councilman Chitwood, motion carried.

CLAIMS:

Upon motion made by Councilman Black, seconded by Councilwoman Woolery and carried, Claims Nos. 2716 to 2828, inclusive, were approved and warrants in the total amount of \$28,881.41 ordered issued.

Upon motion by Councilman Black, seconded by Councilwoman Woolery and carried, the meeting adjourned.
