

SPECIAL MEETING

Friday, December 29, 1950.

THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, met in Special Session in the Council Chambers at 1:30 o'clock P. M., on Friday, December 29, 1950, with Mayor Lemon presiding.

ROLL CALL -

Present: Chitwood, Dunn, Parks, Shank, Woolery
Absent: Black, Sikes.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved as read upon motion by Councilwoman Woolery, seconded by Councilman Chitwood. Motion carried.

Councilman Chitwood moved a street light be installed at the intersection of East Second Street and South Mitchell Street. Motion seconded by Councilwoman Woolery and carried.

Councilwoman Woolery moved the Common Council act on the three cent levy which the State Tax Board cut from the City Administration 1951 Budget in the following manner: .03 levy be deducted from item #262 in City Administration Budget. Seconded by Councilman Chitwood, motion carried.

Councilwoman Woolery moved that the Council authorize the Board of Public Works to consummate the land purchase deal with Ralph Rogers, Ralph Mills and Jerry Femal on January 1, 1951, as per agreement. The deed will be subject to approval by the City Attorney and is to be delivered without restrictions. Seconded by Councilman Chitwood, motion carried.

Claims Nos. 3702 to 3763, inclusive, were approved and warrants ordered issued upon motion by Councilwoman Woolery, seconded by Councilman Parks, in the amount of \$3,278.61.

Upon motion by Councilwoman Woolery, seconded by Councilman Chitwood, the meeting adjourned.
