Topics Discussed:

The Common Council met nightly from August 17-20, 2020 to discuss the 2021 Budget for the City of Bloomington as proposed by Mayor John Hamilton. Each department presented its budget for 2021 and received a preliminary vote from the Common Council. Throughout the remainder of August and September, the administration will work with the Common Council and various departments to prepare a final version of the 2021 budget for the City of Bloomington. In October, the Common Council hears the budget and makes a final vote. At that time, councilmembers may vote to reduce the budget but may not add to the budget.

ACTION: Do Pass Recommendation for Fire 2021 Budget: Ayes: 9, Nays: 0, Abstain: 0.

MOTION: Volan moved and it was seconded to limit public comment to two and a half hours.

ACTION: The motion received a roll call vote of Ayes: 6, Nays: 3 (Sgambelluri, Rosenbarger, Flaherty), Abstain: 0.

ACTION: Do Pass Recommendation for Police 2021 Budget: Ayes: 1 (Rollo), Nays: 2 (Smith, Sandberg), Abstain: 6.
