Beverly Calender-Anderson, Director of Community and Family Resources, introduced Jenna Whiteaker, the After Hours Ambassador.

Whiteaker gave a brief summary of her education and work experience. She then explained what her job as the After Hours Ambassador entailed.

Doris Sims, Director of HAND, reported on the HAND Consolidated Planning Process for the Community Development Block Grant and the home investment programs. She explained why the planning process was important and necessary regarding fair housing opportunities. Sims said HAND reached out to the public to ask how the Community Development Block Grant should be spent and many people asked for more affordable housing.

Rollo reminded the public that the Land Use Committee had a meeting on August 28, 2019 for a second hearing regarding the planned unit development on 1800 North Walnut.

Volan presented the legislation. He provided a map to illustrate the Ordinance.


Volan moved and it was seconded that Amendment 01 to <u>Ordinance 19-13</u> be adopted.	Amendment 01 to <u>Ordinance 19-13</u> :
Amendment 01 to <u>Ordinance 19-13</u> Synopsis: This amendment is sponsored by Cm. Volan and adds the south side of the portion of East 17th that runs along the northern border of the Garden Hill Residential Neighborhood Permit Parking Zone. This change will allow residents of single family household detached dwellings to obtain a permit and park a vehicle on the street in an otherwise legal parking space. Please note that the amendment reflects this change in the title and corrects the enacting clause.	
Volan presented the amendment to the council. There was council discussion.
