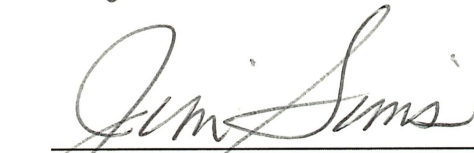

At the conclusion of the hearing, the Common Council could consider a resolution terminating the tax abatement. The council attorney was directed to mail the statutorily-required written notice to the property owner.
