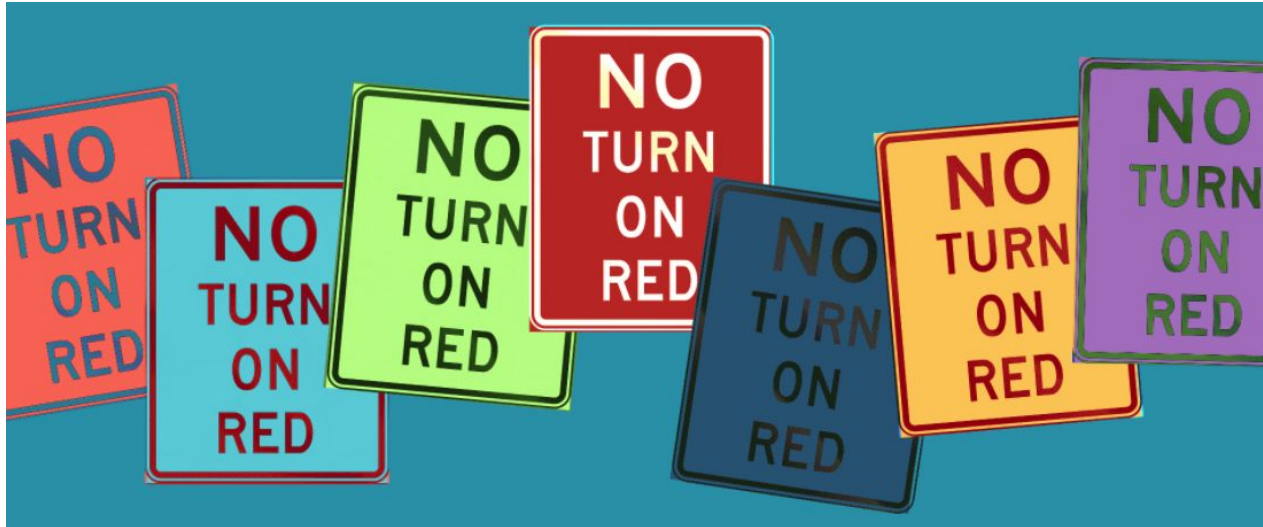

# Prohibit RTOR in Dense Areas

- Downtown overlay signalized intersections
- Campus signalized intersections



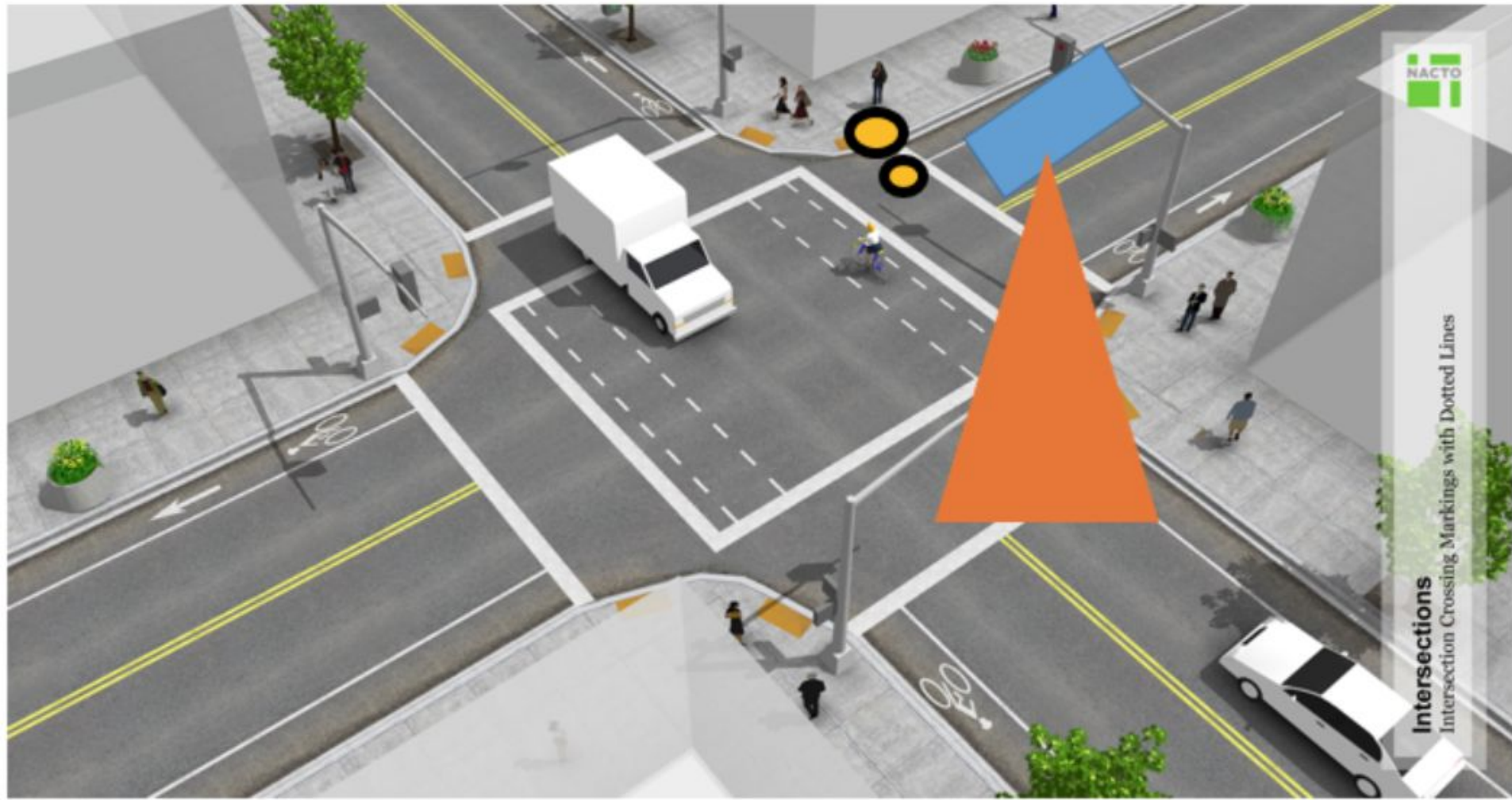
Higher risk to pedestrians and people bike if right turns on red are allowed.

We are looking at national trends because our sample size is so small.



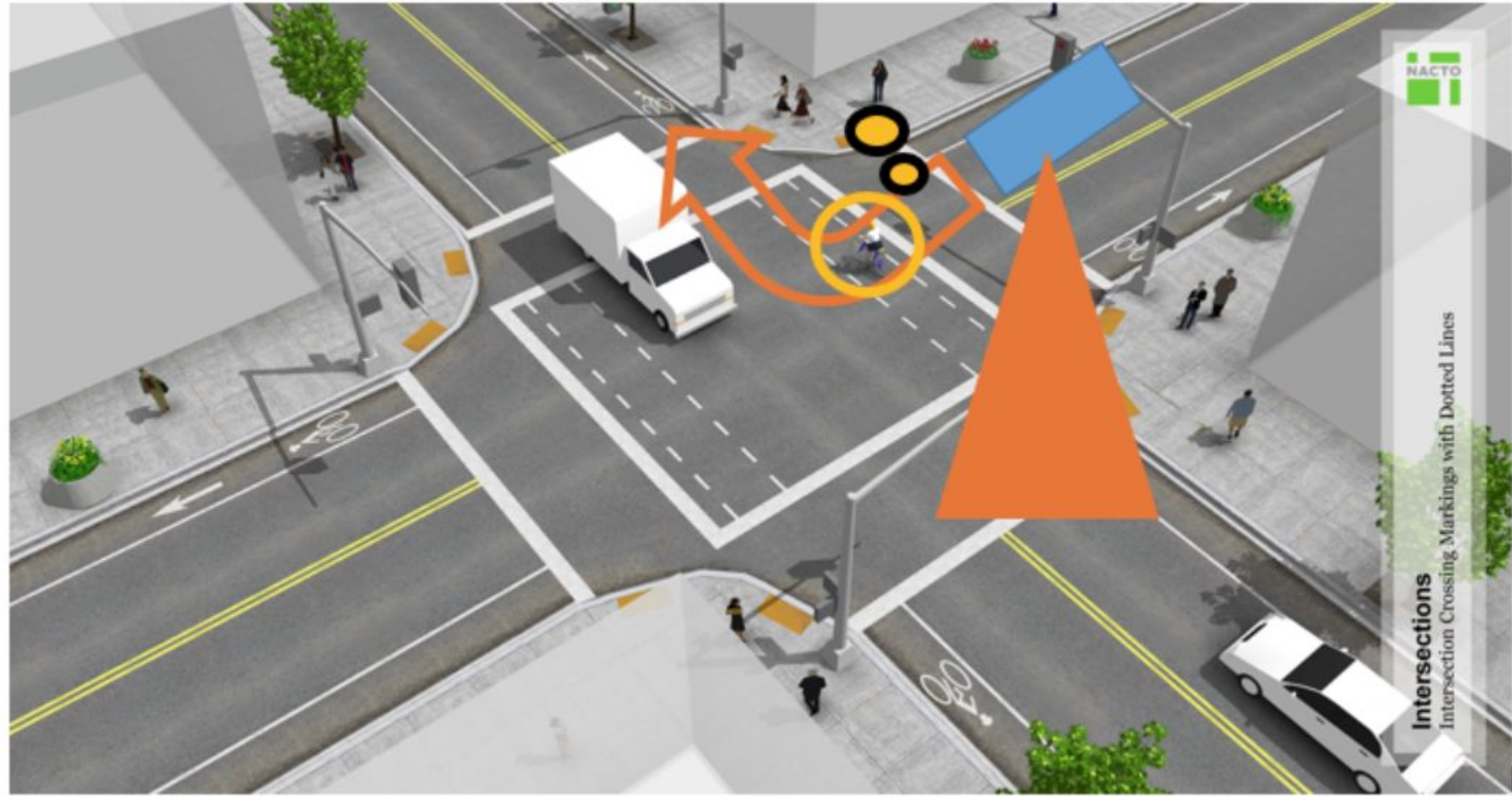
