1. **Ordinance 21-45** - To Amend Title 7 of the Bloomington Municipal Code Entitled "Animals" – Re: Amending Chapter 7.01 (Definitions); Chapter 7.16 (Commercial Animal Establishment Permits); Chapter 7.54 (Fees); and Chapter 7.56 (Enforcement Procedure)
