BLOOMINGTON BOARD OF PUBLIC SAFETY

The Bloomington Board of Public Safety held a Regular Session on **Tuesday, January 18, 2022, at 6:00 p.m.**, Teleconference/Virtual Meeting.

CALL TO ORDER

Board President Kim Gray called the meeting to order at approximately 6:00 p.m. Board members Luis Fuentes-Rohwer, Rafi Hasan and Maqubé Reese were present.

Board members Shruti Rana was not present.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS

Board member Maqubé Reese moved that Kim Gray remain board chair/president, and board member Rafi Hasan seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously, 4-0, through a roll call vote by board recording secretary, Nicole DeCriscio Bowe.

Board member Rafi Hasan moved that Maqubé Reese remain vice-chair of the board, and board member Luis Fuentes-Rohwer seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously, 4-0, through a roll call vote by board recording secretary, Nicole DeCriscio Bowe.

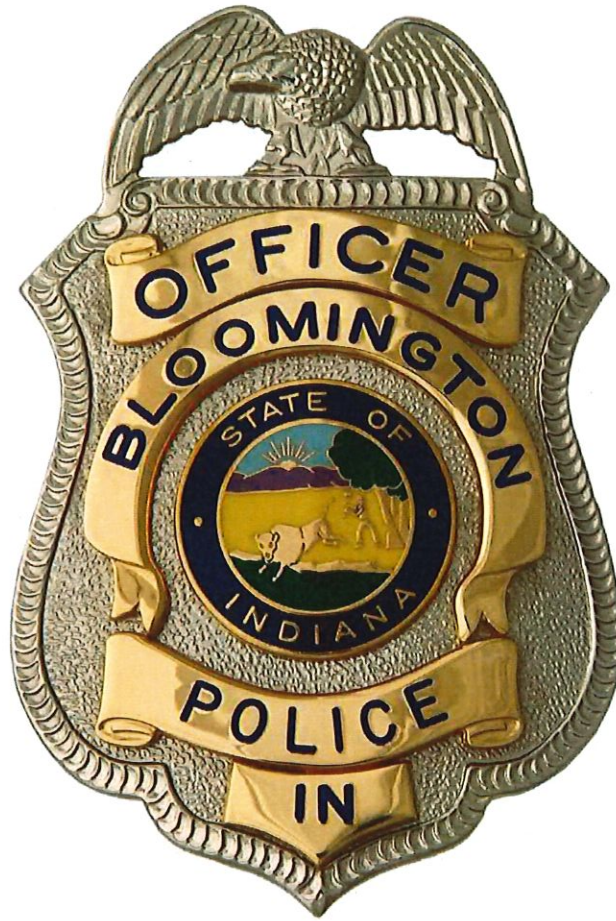

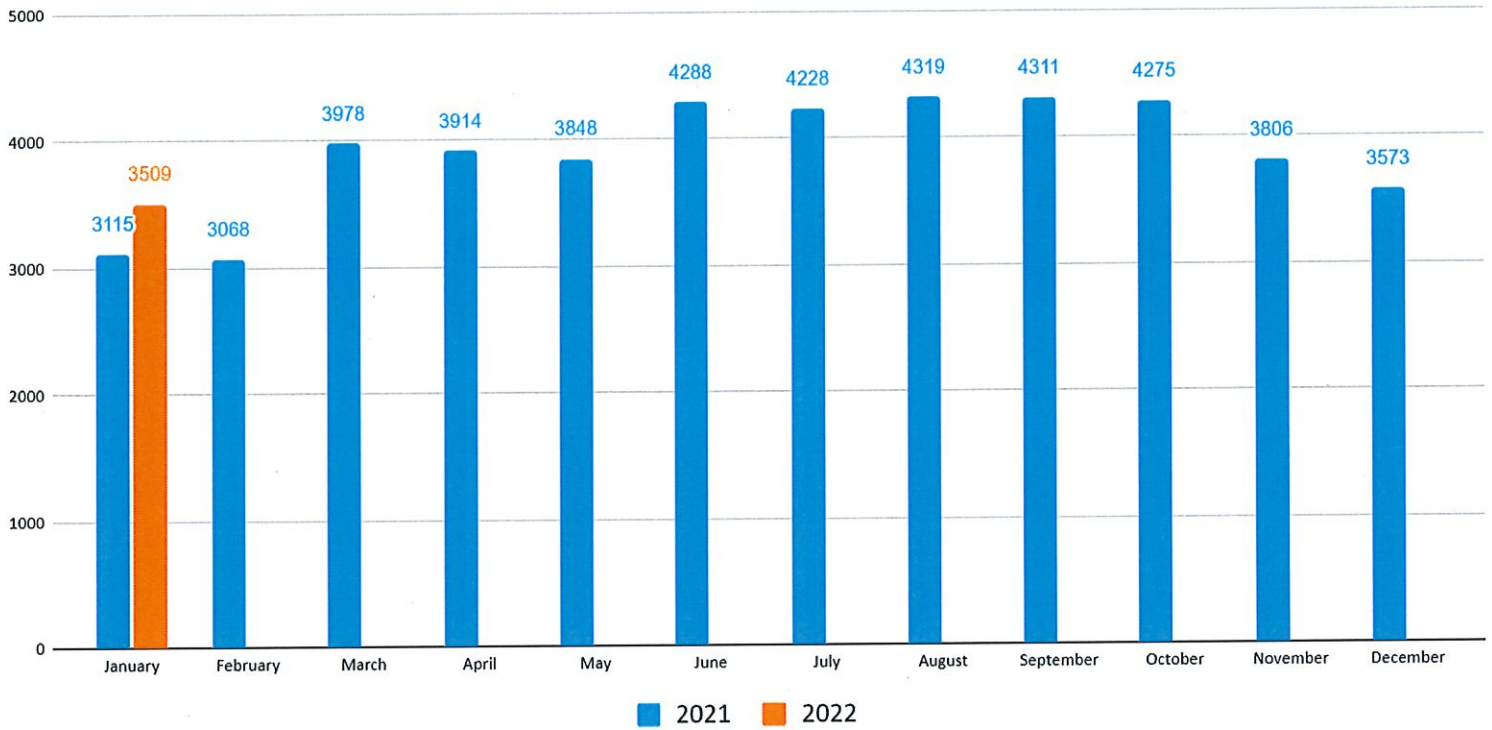

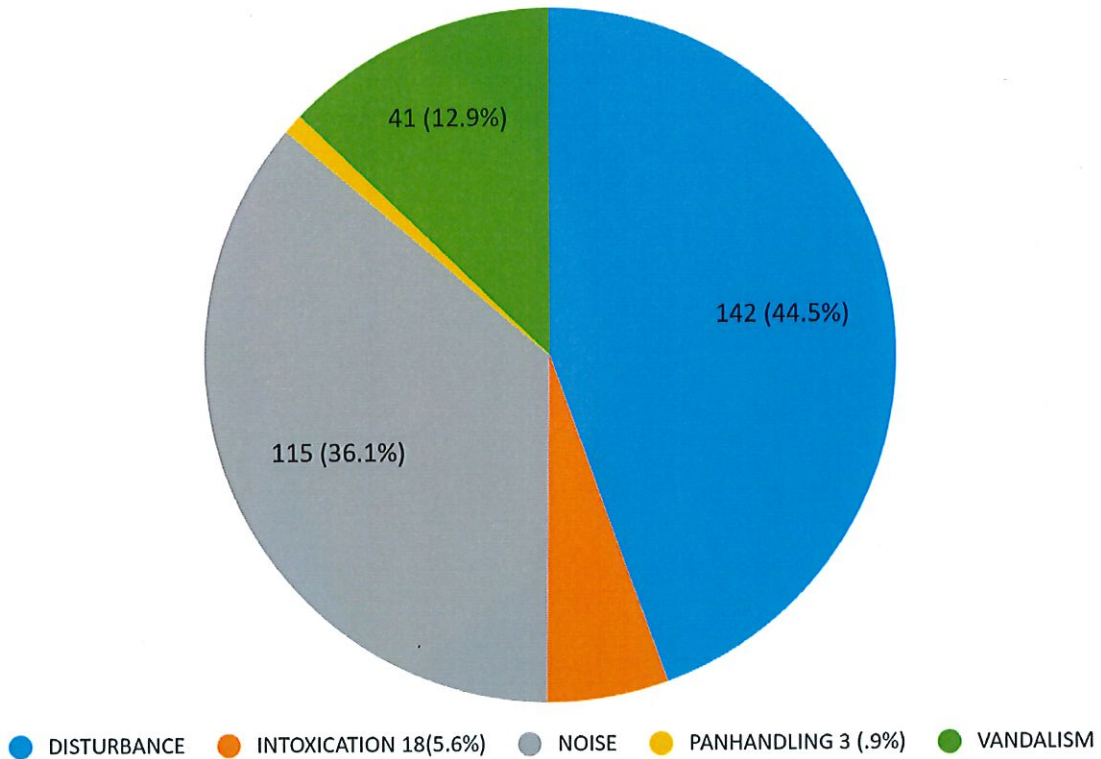

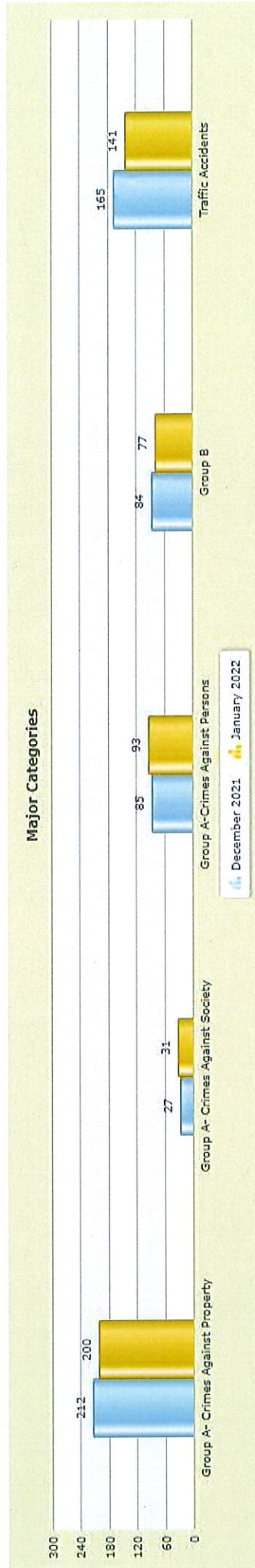
2021-2022 Calls For Service Totals

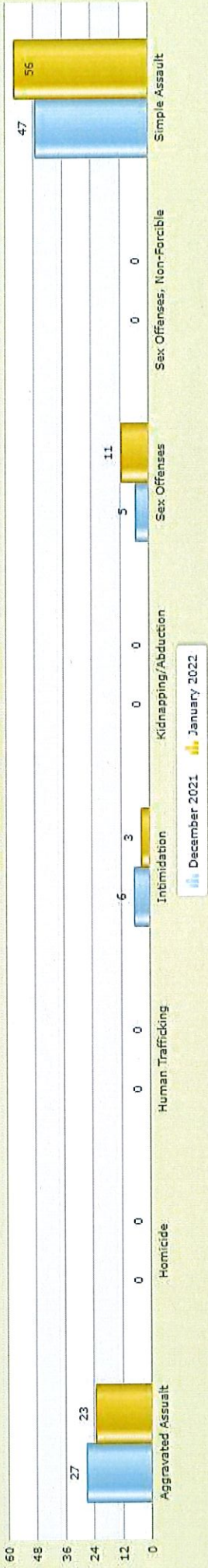
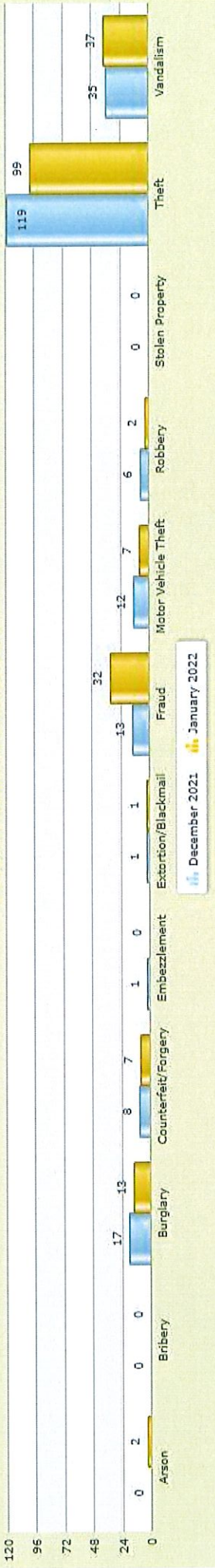

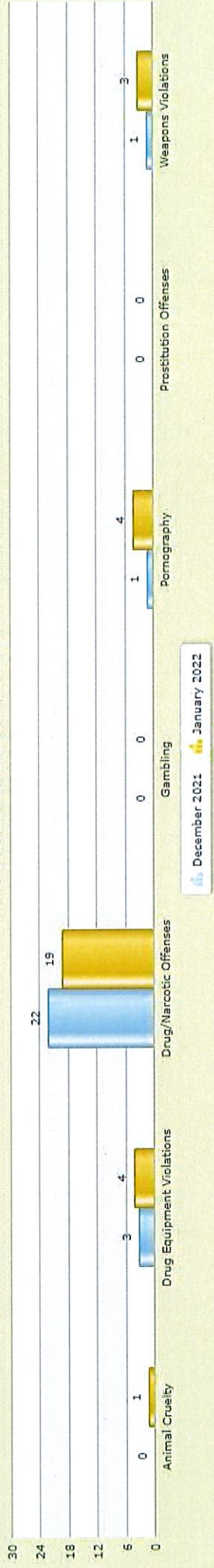

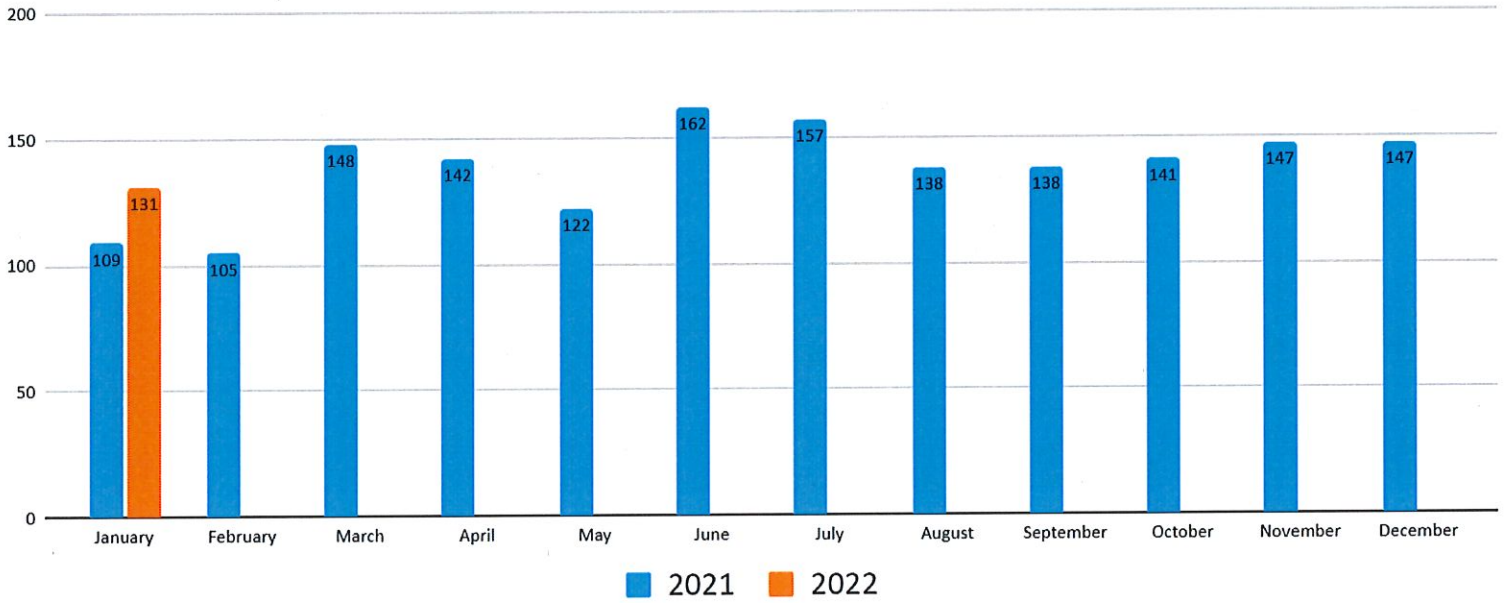

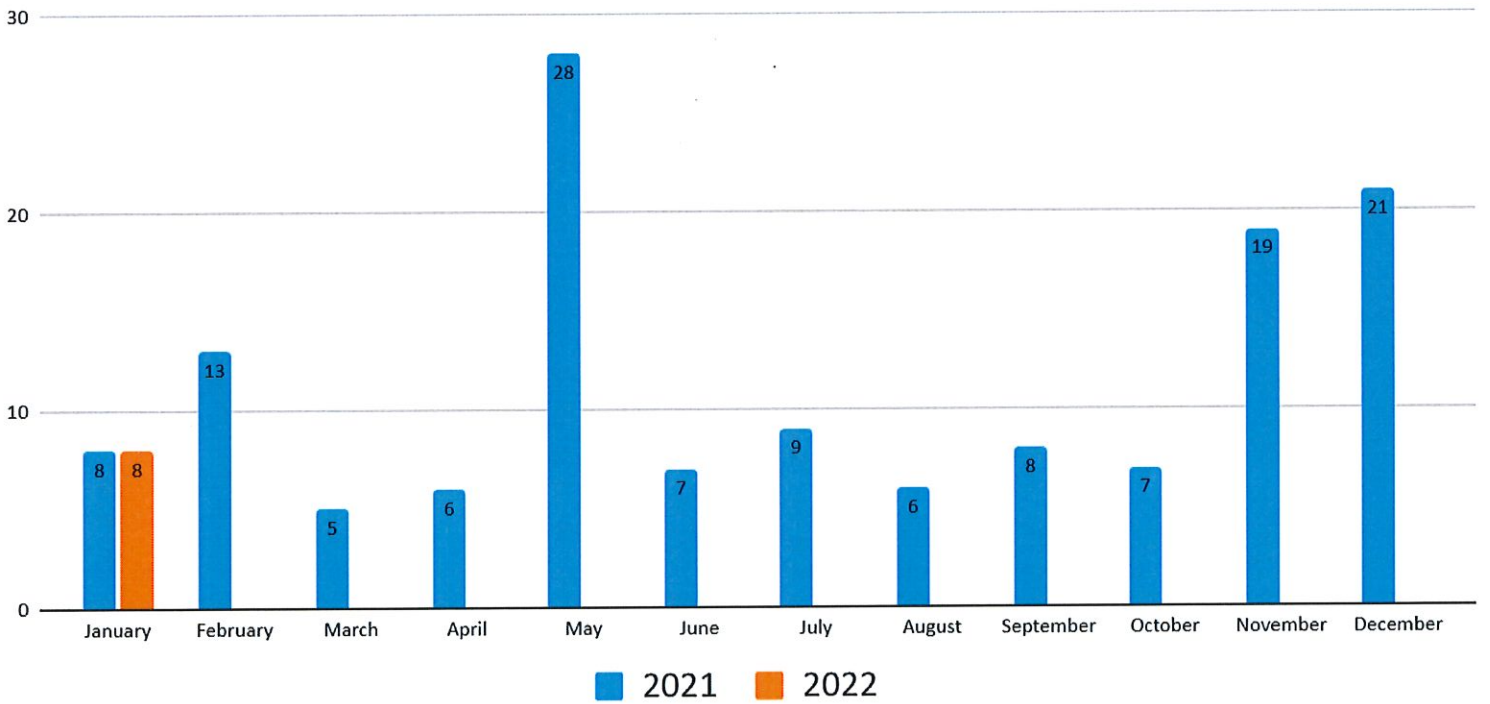

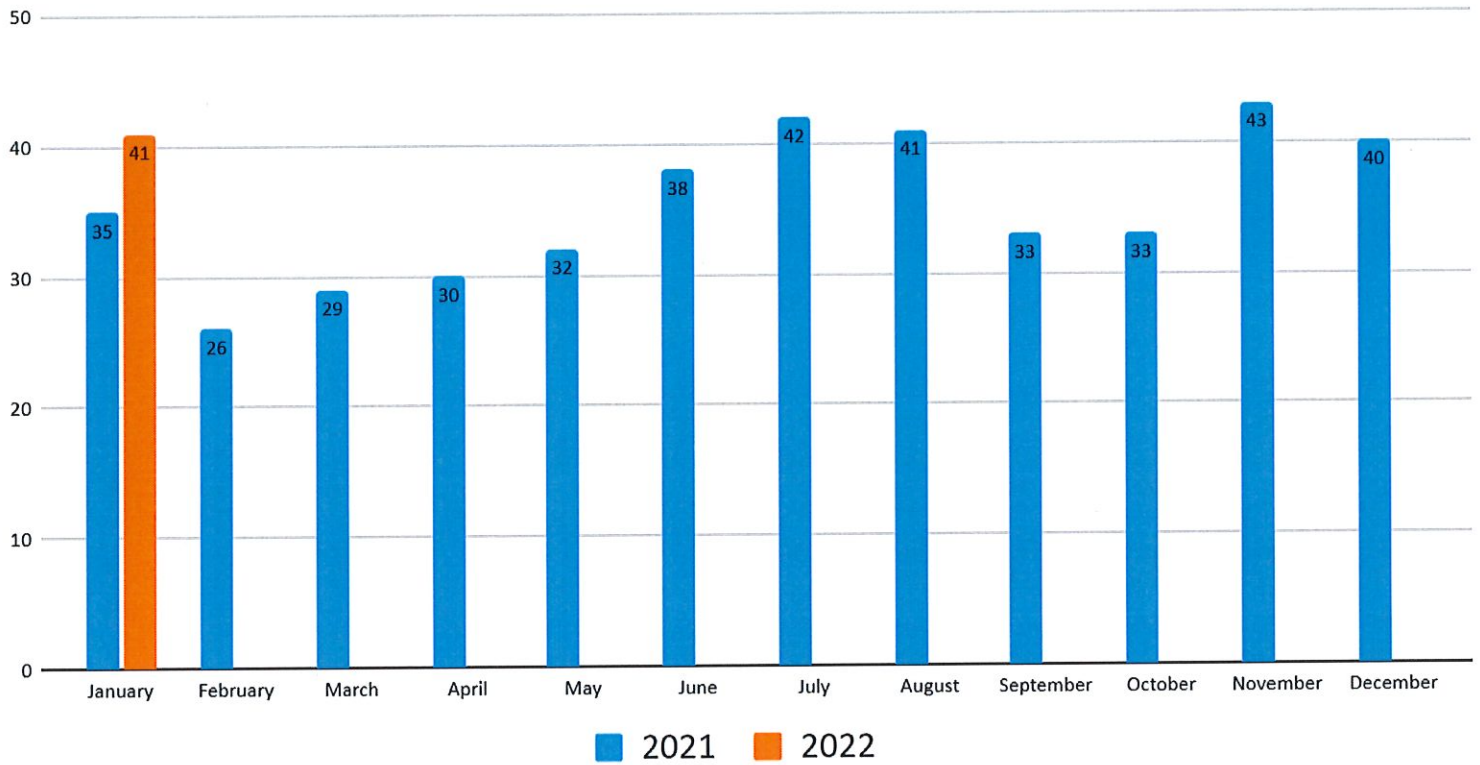
2021-2022 Adult Arrests

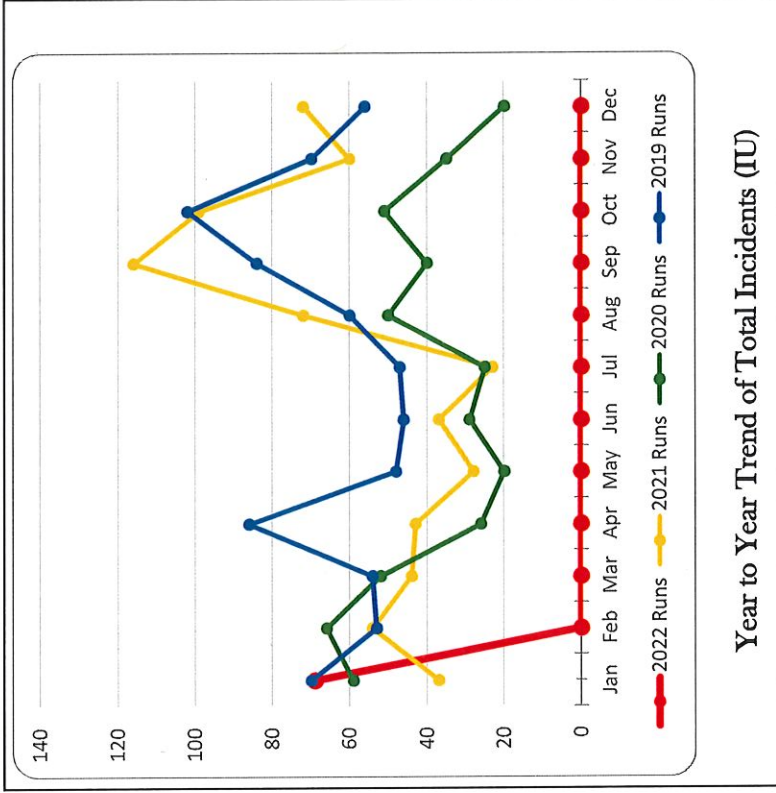

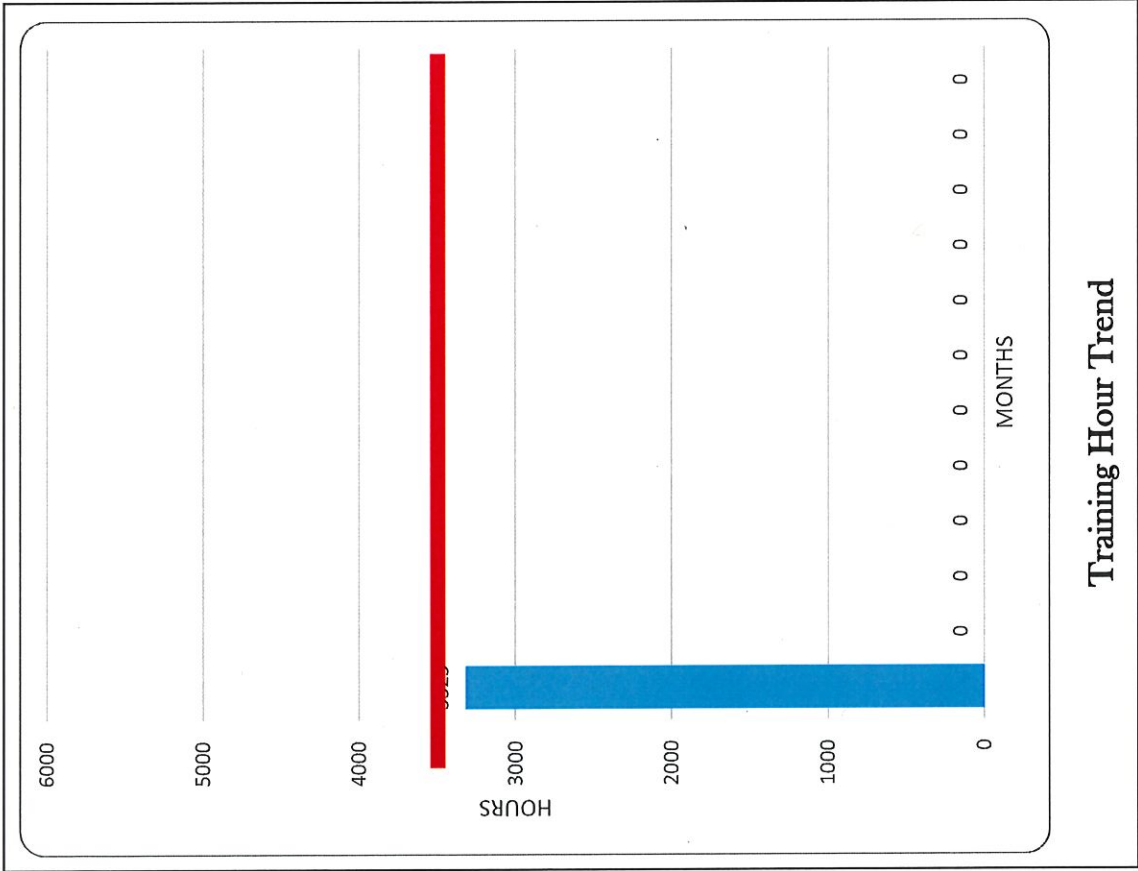

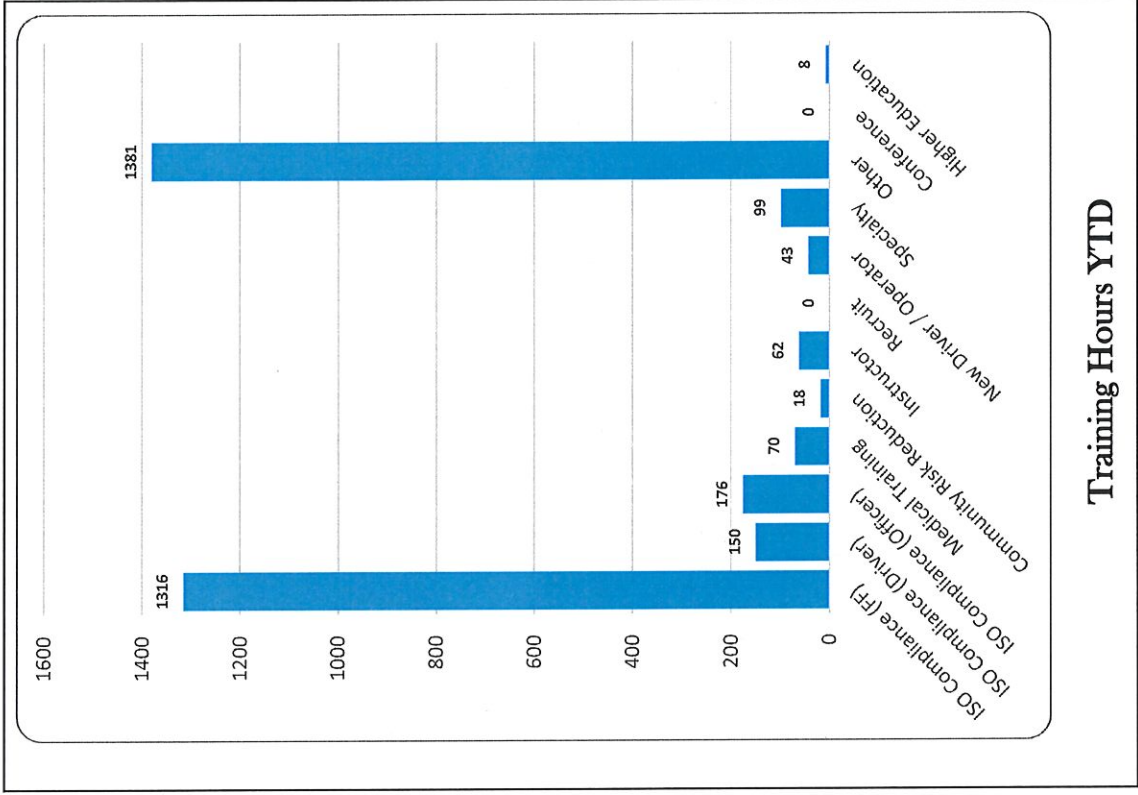
