- [Just Transition](#)
 - Indigenous peoples-led economic movement of the Climate Justice Alliance, based on Bolivian and Ecuadorian indigenous peoples struggles
 - From extractive to regenerative
 - From exploitative to just and equitable
 - 8 principles - Top 3 chosen by local citizens:
 - Buen Vivir - Live well at the expense of no one (aka economic security for all)
 - Equitable distribution (locally focused on housing and transit)
 - Regenerative systems (locally focused on climate action and transit)
