Goal-setting for remainder of 2020:

- 1. Database of businesses offering eco-friendly takeout options
  - a. Due to COVID, more people are getting takeout
  - b. Start with establishing list of all businesses offering compostable or recyclable takeout options
  - c. Eventually we would like for this list to be made public in polished PDF format either on the Bloomington Sustainability website or via a community organization
  - d. Samantha will take the lead on starting a spreadsheet, committee members will each identify businesses to reach out to <u>http://www.openforbloomington.com/</u>
- 2. Audit of apartment complexes and their recycling options
  - a. This has been an ongoing concern for the City of Bloomington
  - b. There are so many apartment complexes and townhome developments where recycling is not available
  - c. Anna will look into whether an existing document like this exists, or start a new one for the Waste Reduction Committee to work on throughout the fall
- 3. Composting Initiative
  - a. Jerrett worked on researching composting initiatives last fall and will take the lead on raising public awareness this fall through a possible town hall event
  - b. Information on how to compost is overwhelming and the committee would like to help educate the community on the options available
  - c. Possible partners for a composting event:
    - i. Green Camino can promote their services
    - ii. Mother Hubbard's Cupboard do they still accept composting donations?
    - iii. Event should also provide attendees with individual experiences to demonstrate possibility to compost on your own / for free
