  - i. James—says it went well

    - 1. Patrick---thinks it was great, people enjoyed themselves, he likes how well we worked together.
      - a. Patrick suggested that if we are going doing snow again, we need to have a tarp, and that we be more intentional about clean up and specific responsibilities.
    - 2. There was some confusion on where furniture would be left and how we should leave the room
    - 3. Dianne—felt that for activities—we need good and solid activities—
      - a. She mentioned that the snow molding for the activity was expired,
      - b. Said she has background on early childhood education and can pair with director on working with being more intentional about ensuring that we really have the kids in mind while we are conceptualizing the way the event will go

        - ii. We may get Pizza X for Black History month kick-off. We go to them for Juneteenth, especially for Black Malke Youth Summitt
      - e. Dianna suggested that would look to other pizzerias for pizza for the Winter Wonderland event

  - i. Andrew—there were very few left and the rest were given out to those who asked if there were any left.
- h. Dianne
  - i. Suggested taking Polaroid pictures
