Sample Messages:

- 1. Ordering more takeout these days? Lots of great Bloomington businesses have recyclable or compostable takeout containers. When you place an order, be sure to ask whether the takeout container can be recycled!
- 2. Styrofoam is non-biodegradable and is no longer accepted by the Monroe County Solid Waste Management District. When ordering takeout, request a cardboard or recyclable plastic container if you can.
- 3. Did you know that DeAngelo's has compostable drinking straws? Also, if requested, they will put down foil to prevent grease from getting onto your pizza box so that you can recycle it.
- 4. Did you know that poke bowl containers from InBloom Eats are compostable?
- 5. Shoutout to the following restaurants for offering compostable takeout containers: Aver's Pizza, Crumble Coffee, DeAngelo's, InBloom Eats, Inkwell, Lennie's. Know of another restaurant offering compostable takeout containers? Let us know by contacting _____.
- 6. Did you know that Lennie's composts their pre- and post-consumer food waste?

Other restaurants using mainly compostable/recyclable takeout materials that could be plugged in above:

- Feta Kitchen: bottom part of their bowls are compostable, lids are recyclable plastic
- Cardinal Spirits: compostable clamshells, paper bags, occasional plastic containers that are recyclable
- Chipotle: bottom part of bowl is compostable, lid is recyclable foil
- Hive: most takeout containers are compostable or recyclable, compostable utensils and paper straws
- Upland: takeout containers are compostable
