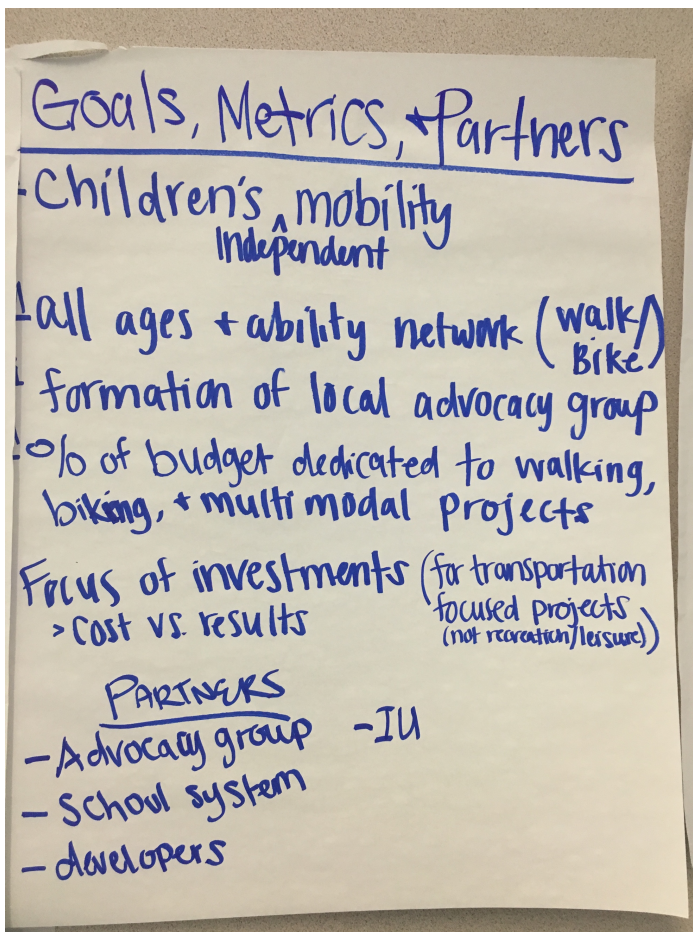
- Formation of local advocacy group
