

NOTICE: PUBLIC HEARING TO REPLACE ZONING ORDINANCE

The City of Bloomington Plan Commission (“PC”) will consider the adoption of a proposed zoning ordinance (“Proposal”) and repealing the previous Unified Development Ordinance (“UDO”) at a public hearing on **August 26, 2019, at 5:30 PM at 401 N. Morton Street, Council Chambers**. The Proposal applies to all areas within the corporate boundaries. The Proposal is for replacement of the UDO with a new version based on guidance from the 2018 Comprehensive Plan. Penalty and forfeiture provisions in the current UDO remain the same in the Proposal. The Proposal, including penalty and forfeiture provisions (20.06.100 Enforcement and Penalties), is available for inspection from 8 AM to 5 PM M-F (excluding holidays) at the Planning and Transportation Department in City Hall, 401 N. Morton Street, Suite 130, Bloomington, Indiana 47404 and at: <https://bloomington.in.gov/planning/udo/update>.

Written objections to the proposal that are filed with the secretary of the PC before the hearing will be considered and oral comments concerning the proposal will be heard. The hearing may be continued from time to time as may be found necessary.
