

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO ADOPT A REPLACEMENT ZONING ORDINANCE

The City of Bloomington Plan Commission (“PC”) will consider the adoption of text amendments to the Unified Development Ordinance (“UDO Amendments”) and a proposed zoning conversion map (“Map Proposal”) that updates existing zoning districts to conform with a new UDO at a public hearing on **March 9, 2020, at 5:30 PM at 401 N. Morton Street, Council Chambers.**

The Map Proposal and UDO Amendments apply to all areas within the corporate boundaries. The Map Proposal and UDO Amendments are based on guidance from the 2019 UDO Update Process. The Proposal and Amendments, which do not amend any penalty or forfeiture provisions, are available for inspection in their entirety from 8 AM to 5 PM M-F (excluding holidays) at the Planning and Transportation Department in City Hall, 401 N. Morton Street, Suite 130, Bloomington, Indiana 47404 and at: <https://bloomington.in.gov/planning/udo/update>.

Written objections to the proposal that are filed with the secretary of the PC before the hearing will be considered and oral comments concerning the proposal will be heard. The hearing may be continued from time to time as may be found necessary.
