City Announces Spring Cleanup at Rose Hill Cemetery

Bloomington, Ind.—The Bloomington Parks and Recreation Department is conducting its annual spring cleanup of Rose Hill Cemetery this month.

According to Parks and Recreation Department operations office assistant Jennifer Barber, the annual cleanup includes removing and disposing of floral arrangements and grave decorations that are broken, damaged or that do not meet grave decoration guidelines. Non-compliant items include shepherd's hooks, flower vases or other decorations inserted directly into the ground, and all glass or ceramic decorations.

Guidelines for permissible decorations and placement are posted in the kiosk at Rose Hill Cemetery, and are available online at bloomington.in.gov/locations/rose-hill-cemetery.

The cleanup at White Oak Cemetery will take place after Memorial Day.
