Griffy Lake Watercraft Rental Agreement



Rules and Regulations

- 1. **NO SWIMMING.** No persons may abandon any watercraft at any time.
- 2. No electric or gas powered motors are allowed on Griffy Lake.
- 3. One (1) U.S. Coast Guard approved life preserver must be accessible to each occupant of a watercraft. While stand up paddle boarding, each person shall wear an ankle leash. Minors, age 12 and under, must wear Coast Guard approved PFDs at all times.
- 5. Minors, age 14 and under, wishing to use any vessel without adult supervision, must have written permission signed by a parent or legal guardian.
- 6. No watercraft shall be operated within 200 feet of the dam or east of the buoys located near the causeway.
- 7. Boat mooring is prohibited on any shoreline.
- 8. No persons shall operate any watercraft which is loaded with passengers or cargo beyond the manufacturer's recommended carrying capacity.
- 9. No watercraft shall be operated or used in such a manner so as to create a nuisance or disrupt the safety of others.
- 10. All watercraft must use the launch ramp provided at the east end of the lake.
- 11. Absolutely no litter shall be deposited in the lake or on the shoreline.
- 12. At the conclusion of the rental, persons shall only bring watercrafts back into the launch bay when instructed by Boathouse Staff. Otherwise persons shall float ideal ~20 ft. away from dock.
- 13. All watercrafts must be returned within specified rental time or before the boathouse closes on the same day as rental. Failure to comply may result in a \$20 late fee.
- 14. Any rented items or watercrafts that are lost, stolen, or damaged will be subject to a \$50 replacement fee.

Violations of this agreement may result in dismissal from the property, and the renter may be denied further use of rental boats. Swimming, littering, and alcohol/narcotic use may result in fines. I have read and fully understand these policies and rules regarding boat rental at Griffy Lake, and agree to abide thereby and shall require all other passengers in my party to do likewise. Renter, including its agents, and assigns, does hereby agree to release, hold harmless, and indemnify the City of Bloomington, its Parks and Recreation Department, and any and all employees, agents, and assigns from any and all claims, causes of action, suits, proceedings, or demands, including but not limited to claims involving personal injury, sickness or death, which may arise from this Agreement.
