Walnut • All other Electronics are accepted FREE of charge al ALL District recycling centers.

FREON APPLIANCES: There is a \$20 fee for Freon appliances (refrigerators, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, etc.) to cover the cost of properly managing the Freon • Non Freon containing appliances are accepted as scrap metal at ALL District recycling centers free of charge. TIRES: restrictions and fees apply


