## Check Eligibility

- Must be located in the Bloomington Entertainment and Arts District (Downtown Bloomington)
- Must hold a valid Monroe County Health Department permanent retail food establishment license.
- Mobile food vendors & temporary/seasonal food service license not eligible for this program at this point in time

## Apply & Submit Forms

- Submit a copy of your Monroe County Health Department permanent retail food establishment license with your application

## Receive a Waste Audit & Staff Training

- Upon confirmation of your selection, EarthKeepers will conduct a waste audit and staff training.
- You will then receive your bins, buckets, and marketing materials and composting collection will begin

## 3 Month Trial

- Your free trial concludes after 3 months
- You will then receive a discounted quote with the option to continue your composting service

## Provide Feedback

- At conclusion of your trial, you will receive an evaluation form to share your experience.
