

#### **Survey Methodology**

- 4th time conducting the Bloomington Resident Survey
  - Previous iterations in 2017, 2019 and 2021
- Survey conducted from March 20<sup>th</sup> to May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023
- Sampling approach employed:
  - Multi-contact approach (postcard + printed survey + postcard)
  - Probability-based, mail-based sample of 3,000 households
  - 367 total responses received
  - 13% overall response rate
- Results statistically weighted to reflect Bloomington population
- 95% confidence interval with a +/- 5% margin of error





#### **Comparisons to National Benchmarks**








#### **Comparisons to Peer Benchmarks**











#### 7 in 10 residents:






#### Community Characteristics Ratings, 2021-2023



Please rate each of the following characteristics as they relate to Bloomington as a whole:










#### Like Least about Living in Bloomington, 2023




What is one thing you like least about the City of Bloomington?













#### Community Engagement Activities, 2021 -2023

City-wide highspeed internet access is a top priority.







#### High-speed Internet Importance






#### **Quality of Government Services, 2021-2023**




Overall, how would you rate the quality of the services provided by each of the following?



#### City of Bloomington Performance, 2021-2023






#### Impression of Contact with Bloomington Staff






