## ROSE HILL SCATTER GARDEN

The Rose Hill Scatter Garden was established in August 2023 as a designated area in Rose Hill Cemetery for cremated remains to be scattered or cast.

The shared memorial provides a place for individuals whose remains have been cast there to have their names and dates engraved.

Families and loved ones may cast a portion of their love one's cremains in the scatter garden even if cremains are also to be scattered elsewhere. The scatter garden offers a permanent and accessible place to remember, reflect and share with future generations.

## SCATTER GARDEN FEES

- Scattering of cremains only—\$300
- Scattering of cremains & memorial engraving—\$575

## POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

- A licensed funeral director is required to be on site during the scattering/casting of ashes.
- 24-hour notice is required from funeral directors prior to the scattering/casting of ashes.
- Scattering/casting ceremonies cannot be scheduled on Sundays or City holidays.
- Funeral directors will provide a burial transit permit and check for payment.
- This is due upon arrival at the cemetery prior to or immediately after the service.
- Only designated cemetery staff may perform the scattering/casting of ashes.
- Names and dates will be added to the memorial stone twice a year.
