- Completed application
- \$20 non-refundable jury fee
- All applicants must provide three (3) digital photos of work and one (1) of display for our jury to ritterc@bloomington.in.gov by Friday, February 16 at 5 p.m.
- Personal care category artists must submit a product sample.

Product guidelines

- · All work must be original and made by the applicant.
- · Significant alteration of commercial components in any work is required.
- Work must be safe, be a durable (not consumable) good, and exhibit quality of craftsmanship.
- If work is made from or includes dried flowers, the flowers must be grown by applicant.

Unacceptable work includes



- Work made from kits.
- Work made from molds not made by applicant.
- Work made by someone other than applicant (including commercially made products, imports and products bought for resale).
- Work that would be considered drug paraphernalia.



Criteria for selecting artists

- Product meets quidelines established above.
- Quality of work: Work will be juried based on application materials submitted.
- Price range: Pieces available for sale should be reasonably priced.
- Applications will be divided into 10 categories:
 - · clay

- metalwork/woodwork
- drawing/painting/
- natural materials
- photography
- personal care
- · fiber arts
- (candles/soap)

· glass

- recycled arts
- jewelry
- surface decoration

Artists must choose ONE category which best represents the majority of product created and sold. This is the category in which artwork will be juried. Provide images of sample products only in this category. A minimum of 80% of the product you sell must be within this category. If you wish to sell equally in multiple categories, please submit a separate application for each including separate photos and application fees.

- Artists are selected through a jury process. The jury is comprised of local individuals who have a vested interest in A Fair of the Arts and/or local arts. The jury will select artists based on the following criteria:
- product quidelines
- style of work
- quality of work

- price range
- variety of artists

Site information



- Fernandez Plaza is located at 8th and Morton Streets in Bloomington.
- Water is available at the site.
- · A Parks and Recreation staff member (who is certified in CPR/AED and first aid) will be available to answer questions, assist with traffic control, and ensure the smooth operation of the Fair.

Booth and sales information



- Booth spaces are 10' x 10'.
- · Cost is \$60 per Saturday.
- Accepted artists will be placed in up to four Fairs.
- Commissions are not collected on sales.
- Although exhibitors are required to be present in their booths, booth sitters are available for restroom breaks.
- Demonstrations by exhibitors are encouraged with prior approval.
- Exhibitors wishing to share a booth must submit separate applications, noting that they wish to share one booth.
- All displays must be set up by 7:30 a.m. (8:30 a.m. in October) and exhibitors may not tear down until 1 p.m.

Timeline

- January 8—Applications emailed and posted at bloomington.in.gov/afair.
- February 16—Application deadline at 5 p.m. to receive full consideration. All applicants applying after this date will be waitlisted only. We will contact artists from the waitlist as cancellations occur.
- March 22—Accepted artists announced.
- April 19—Booth payment and signed contract due.
