## Reminder of Action Required: Register for Online Fats, Oils, and Grease Reporting Program

The City of Bloomington Utilities (CBU) is pleased to announce a new online reporting system to support our fats, oils, and grease (FOG) program via SwiftComply. This implementation aims to standardize and improve compliance with the City of Bloomington Utilities' grease control regulation.

Beginning **August 1, 2022**, all food service establishments (FSEs) within the City of Bloomington Utilities' jurisdiction will be encouraged to submit manifests digitally. As a service provider, you are highly encouraged to participate and upload manifests on behalf of your FSE customers.

CBU will be hosting our second <u>Required</u> Preferred Pumper Program (PPP) training at CBU Service Center on August 16, 2022 at 9:00 am. Starting October 3, 2022, haulers <u>must be included</u> in the CBU PPP to be eligible to haul grease waste in the City of Bloomington.

**What do I gain?** Uploading manifests electronically will ensure that your customers do not skip pump outs and provide accurate records.
