Location

Lake Monroe Sailing Association is located at 7600 S. Shields Ridge Rd. From South Walnut, turn on Fairfax Road. Go past Bloomington Speedway, turn left on Moffett. Go past the bait shop to Handy Road ("T" intersection). Turn right and follow signs to the water treatment plant. Go past the plant and down the hill to LMSA. The driveway is on the right side of the road.

Adult Sailing

Bloomington Parks and Recreation and the Lake Monroe Sailing Association offer two types of sailing experiences: keel boat and small boat. Schedules are flexible and include a two-day class or a three-day class that includes US Sailing certification.

Small Boat: This class offers a simple way to get started in sailing! Plan to be wet and in the water!

For ages 18 yrs. and up.

Keel Boat: No previous experience is required. This course covers rigging, sailing and docking boats approximately 25' long, and is the first step for those dreaming of owning a keel boat or cruising. It is also appropriate for those with limitations that make handling small boats difficult.

Youth Sailing

Have an active summer on Lake Monroe learning and practicing sailing techniques and theories with qualified and experienced instructors. No previous sailing experience is required.

Equipment

The boats used in camp are Sunfish, Lasers and Club 420s.

Swimming Skills

Participants should have some basic swimming ability. During the program every student is required to wear a life jacket when near the water. Coast Guard-approved life jackets will be provided; however, students may bring their own if they wish.

What to Bring

Each participant needs a sack lunch, swimsuit, change of clothes and old shoes or sandals that can be worn in the water. Parents may be asked to stay briefly the first day of camp to fill out health forms, permission slips and emergency information. Parents may also use this time to organize carpools.

What if it rains?

Youth programs operate in inclement weather.

A shelter house and small clubhouse are available for indoor activities such as knot games, sailing films, and simulations.

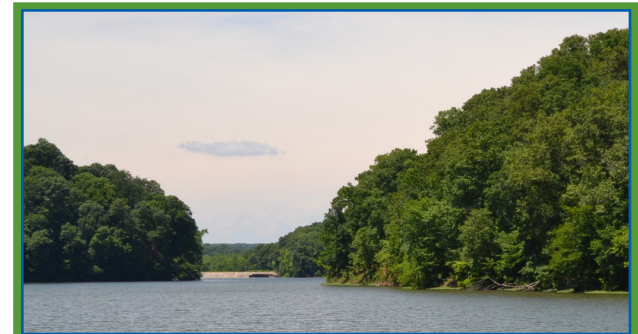
Youth Sailing
