Public Information Meeting: Proposed Stormwater Detention Project

Bloomington, Ind. – The City of Bloomington Utilities Department (CBU) invites residents to join our staff for a public meeting on Thursday, May 2, 2024 at 5:30pm to discuss a proposed stormwater detention system project in your neighborhood.

Detention projects help control stormwater before it enters local waterways or the City’s stormwater infrastructure, known as the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4). Improving stormwater management can reduce localized flooding and erosion and reduce pollutants entering waterways. In Bloomington, stormwater flows directly into streams and water systems without treatment.

The proposed boundaries of the project include:

- North: E. Sheridan Dr.
- East: S. Karen St.
- West: S. Highland Ave.
- South: E. Southdowns Dr.
