

Bloomington Green Home Improvement Program maximum rebate scheme

Rebate amounts are scaled based on household income and project type. The general population qualifies for a rebate equal to 25% of the project cost, up to the maximum rebate amount allowable for each project type. One exception is that the rebate for solar panels is 20%.

Low income homeowners qualify for a rebate equal to 40% of the project cost, up to the maximum rebate amount allowable for each project type.

The minimum rebate is \$500 for any single rebate or project type. This means the minimum project cost is \$2,000 for the general population and \$1,250 for low income households.

For the general population, the maximum rebate amounts are as follows:

- Solar panel systems qualify for up to \$5,000 maximum.
- Battery systems qualify for up to \$5,000 maximum.
- A combined solar and battery system qualifies for up to \$10,000 maximum.
- A level 2 electric vehicle charger qualifies for up to \$500 maximum.
- An EnergyStar certified central air conditioner qualifies for up to \$1,500 maximum.
- A heat pump water heater qualifies for up to \$1,000 maximum.
- An HVAC heat pump qualifies for up to \$2,500 maximum.
- One exterior door qualifies for up to \$750 maximum.
- Window replacement qualifies for up to \$750 maximum.
- Attic insulation or sealing projects qualify for up to \$750 maximum.
- Electrical panel upgrades are granted only if a panel upgrade is necessary to install another qualifying project, and the maximum add-on rebate amount is \$750.

For qualifying low income households, the maximum rebate amounts are as follows:

- Solar panel system qualify for up to \$10,000 maximum.
- Battery systems qualify for up to \$8,000 maximum.
- A combined solar and battery system qualifies for up to \$18,000 maximum.
- A level 2 electric vehicle charger qualifies for up to \$800 maximum.

- An EnergyStar certified central air conditioner qualifies for up to \$2,400 maximum.
- A heat pump water heater qualifies for up to \$1,600 maximum.
- An HVAC heat pump qualifies for up to \$4,000 maximum.
- One exterior door qualifies for up to \$1,200 maximum.
- Window replacement qualifies for up to \$1,200 maximum.
- Attic insulation or sealing projects qualify for up to \$1,200 maximum.
- Electrical panel upgrades are granted only if a panel upgrade is necessary to install another qualifying project, and the maximum add-on rebate amount is \$1,200.
